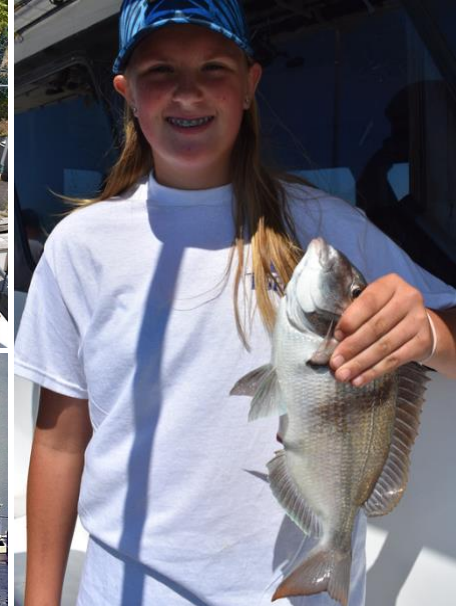




Reel Into Fishing!
